## SCHEDULE OF PLAY

### Practice range schedule

**The practice range is open on: Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday. It is possible to practice on other days as well, but only when there are no players at holes 7 and 8 of the golf course. When golfers are playing hole 6, those practicing on the range must shorten the distance of their shots and change their teeing direction to the right.**

#### Exceptions:

The range is closed according to season schedule or when tournaments are taking place.

Do not play when other golfers are within reach of the ball!

Do not play when people are passing by within reach of the ball!

### 9 - hole course schedule

**The golf course is open on: Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Sunday. It is possible to play on other days as well, but holes 6, 7, 8 and 9 may only be played when nobody is using the practice range.**

#### Exceptions:

The course is closed according to season schedule or when tournaments are taking place.

Hole 7: you are cleared to start playing when players ahead of you arrive at the green of hole 8.

Hole 8: the green of hole 8, which doubles as a putting green, is permanently equipped with putting markers (6) and a hole flag. On this green, players may move their balls freely with out penalty to the left, right or backwards in order to establish a clean line of shot.

Do not play when other golfers are within reach of the ball!

Do not play when people are passing by within reach of the ball!

## LOCAL RULES

### Marker poles:

- white – out of bounds (holes 1, 2 and 6)
- yellow – water trap (hole 4, 5 and 6)
- red – side water trap (hole 5 and 6)
- blue – area under construction
- yellow or red with green cap – biotope (holes 2 and 3)

### Center poles (marking the distance to the center of the green, poles are on both sides of the fairway):

- 150 m – purple pole
- 135 m – orange pole with three black stripes.
- 100 m – orange pole with two black stripes.
- 50 m – orange pole with one black stripe.

### Golf carts:

- drive along the trails. Where there are none, drive on bare ground.
- Loose rocks in the sandtrap: may be removed without penalty.
- Burrowed ball, all parts of the course: relief.
- Ball lands in the biotope: searching in the biotope is not allowed.
- Young trees (up to 3 m in height, marked by poles): ball may be moved without penalty.
- Signposts, benches, trashcans, teeing markers, paths and trails are fixed obstacles: relief.
- Area under repair, parts of course with out grass, marked parts: relief.
- Center poles mark distance to the center of the green, poles are on both sides of the fairway.

**Daily local rules: published on the notice board of the clubhouse.**

## WARNING SIGNALS

Lightning storms pose a particular danger to players on golf courses and practice ranges. When there is a chance of lightning, we ask you to immediately stop playing, leave your equipment on the spot and seek refuge inside the nearby facilities. During tournaments, we will signal potential danger with sound signals as shown in the daily local rules on the clubhouse notice board. Under those circumstances only, players are to observe the sound signals described below. On non-competition days, players must take care of their own safety!

### Sound signals for stopping and continuing play:

- **INTERRUPTION OF PLAY DUE TO LIGHTNING HAZARD:**

**1 long uninterrupted sound signal**

=====

**Danger! Immediately stop playing or practicing!**

Stop playing immediately and retreat to safety. You are not allowed to continue the game until the course marshal approves continuation. If a player does not stop his play immediately they will be disqualified (short putting and practice swings are also forbidden).

- **INTERRUPTION OF PLAY (DUE TO DARKNESS, FOG...):**

**3 short consecutive sound signals / repeated**

Players may finish playing the hole they are currently at.

- **CONTINUING AN INTERRUPTED PLAY:**

**2 short consecutive sound signals / repeated**

Competition: if a player continues the game prior to the above sound signal they will be penalised with a 2 stroke penalty or loss of hole.
